

Of course there are many ways to bid this but the example is to show how Gerber CRO can give you the answers you need.

If North opened 1H playing the 2/1 system South would respond 1NT which shows 6 to 12 points.

With this strong hand North can bid 4C straight away to enquire about aces, where South would respond 5D ie 2 odd aces and 1 king, then North knows exactly which aces South has (ie spades and diamonds) which makes North's hand more powerful so a grand slam can be explored.

Knowing what aces your partner holds can be used to advantage when holding a void, allowing you to assess your hand more accurately.
